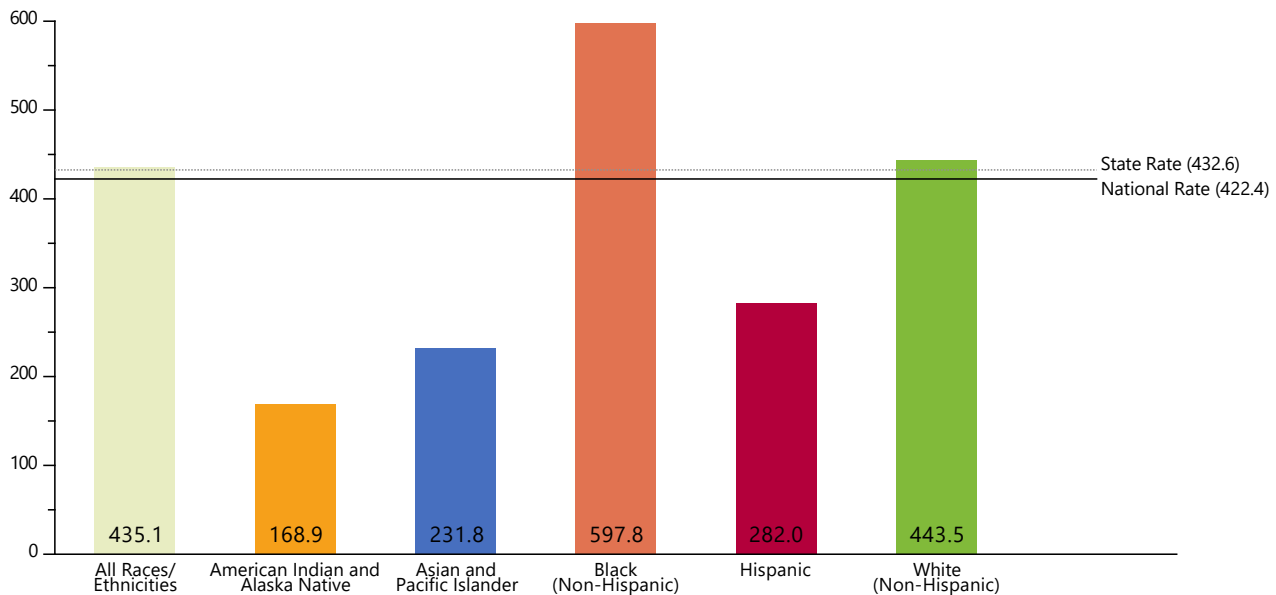

Total Cardiovascular Disease Death Rate per 100,000, All Races/Ethnicities, All Genders, Ages 35+, 2018-2020



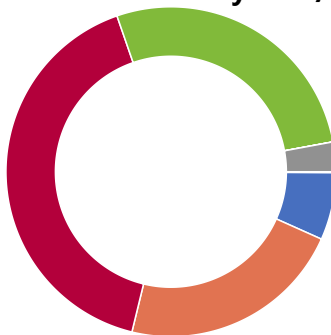

In the state of TX, the average estimated total cardiovascular disease death rate for All Races/Ethnicities, All Genders, Ages 35+ for 2018-2020 is 432.6 Age-Standardized Rate per 100,000.
